

# DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

## KIDS

1. Think of a time when you were afraid of something. What made it so scary? How would you feel differently if your mom and dad or family was there with you?
2. How do you think Daniel and his friends felt in our passage (Daniel 1)? How did God take care of Daniel? How does that show a little bit of God's power?
3. Think of some of the things that God created...make a list (the sun, moon, stars, mountains, planets, animals, people!). How powerful does that prove God to be (REALLY powerful!)? How does it make you feel knowing the REALLY powerful God of the universe knows you, and loves you, and is with you? Even in hard times?

## STUDENTS

1. Think of a time in your life when you felt uncertain. What was your initial reaction? Was there anything that helped you feel better?
2. What is significant about the phrase "God gave?" What does this tell us about God? How might it change our perspective on our circumstances?
3. How does knowing that God is in control, even in the worst moment or in uncertain times, grant us rest?
